Documents that are output from thirdparty systems can be imported and indexed automatically, using information within or accompanying the document.










NATIVE FEATURES

Sets call third-party systems to access the timeliest data for use with OnBase content.






OnBase APIs

{Unity} APIs

- The Unity API is a web service-based API
- Requires a Hyland provided client-side library to develop against
- Libraries are provided in .NET and Java
- This API is also utilized when writing "scripts" that will run inside OnBase, such as Workflow or WorkView


{REST} APIs


- REST APIs based on REST industry standards, including documented using Open API
- Client-side library is not required, allowing for calling from any language
- 3rd party tools can be used to generate client libraries for many different languages

- Point and click ability to create a custom OnBase SOAP or REST web service that can be consumed by third-party applications
- Initiated by other system calling an OnBase web service
